Definitions

<u>Primary Contributory Cause</u> - The factor which is most significant in causing the crash, as determined by officer judgement. <u>Secondary Contributory Cause</u> - The second most significant factor contributing to the crash, as determined by officer judgement.

Example

You determine that vehicle speed is the most significant cause of the crash and texting is the second most significant cause of the crash. Enter 01 in the "PRIMARY" field and 44 in the "SECONDARY" field.
